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Information for Buffalo & WNY Junior Soccer League -- Travel Soccer

Dear Parents

The Holland Soccer Club organizes teams each year involving boys and girls from age 8 to 19. The teams compete in the Buffalo & Western New York Junior Soccer League. All coaches and people involved in running the club are volunteers. The club follows the rules and guidelines of New York State West Youth Soccer Association.

The Travel Soccer outdoor season extends from late April into early August and consists of 10-13 games depending on the age group. During this time most teams practice once or twice per week and play a League game one weeknight per week. Most teams participate in one or more weekend tournaments during the season. Many families postpone summer vacations until after the season. We can not stress enough the importance of each player's and family's commitment to their team. Travel soccer, at least during the outdoor season, is not something you participate in just when it's convenient. You are expected to attend every practice and game during the season. It is not fair to your coaches and teammates, who put in numerous hours practicing and preparing, if you can not commit yourself to the same level of participation.

The price of registration does not include the uniform. Sizing will be done by a board member after the teams have been formed. Email is the preferred form of communication. The managers and coaches are volunteering their time to each team and it makes it so much easier to make sure everyone on the team gets the same information.

We would like to take a moment and express the importance of early registration for summer travel. Our club is one of the latest to register and form teams in our area. Most clubs have their registrations over the summer and their teams are formed by early October. Bonds for each team playing must be paid out on a timely basis to ensure team placement.

In an effort to ensure your child's placement on a team, we strongly suggest that if your child plans on playing travel soccer next summer that you register as soon as possible. This allows us a little leeway within the registration parameters to scout for additional players if needed to form teams within your child's age division. If enough players are not registered for each age division, it could result in children not having a team to play on.

Before you register your child, please take a moment to read the attached zero tolerance policy of the league in which your child will be playing. There is spot near the bottom of the registration to sign that you have read the policy. You are responsible for abiding by the policy whether or not you sign that you have read the policy.
